BUILDING AN ABSTRACT

This is simply a 9-10 sentence project summary in student's own words. You can use this worksheet or make your own Project Abstract and modify it to fit your Science Fair project.

THE FIRST sentence should restate the purpose of the experiment
THE SECOND sentence should restate your hypothesis
THE NEXT sentences should summarize the procedure including how you established the control (this is NOT a list...use sentences)
THE NEXT sentences should summarize the data, including the statistical analysis and error analysis (this is NOT data tables...use sentences to explain the findings)
THE FINAL sentences summarize your conclusion being sure to mention whether the results support the hypothesis. Reference your statistics here that support your conclusion.
