Mr. David Pfaff, MS/HS Principal, shared how EH has now partnered with Changing Footprints, a shoe bank in Greenfield, that helps kids who need shoes acquire them.

Mr. Pfaff also introduced Jimmy, the teacher for the 10 Chinese exchange students from 6th through 10th grade who are attending EH for the month of August. The students are staying with host families and each has an EH student mentor to go through the school day with. They attend classes with their mentor and then meet together during 7th hour with Jimmy to discuss what they have learned/experienced that day.

Jimmy explained that this is the first year their company, Seeker Education Consultant, has sent students overseas in a learning experience such as this. He described the province in China where the students are from as well as their home life, and expressed much gratitude for the kindness and acceptance of his students while they are here. Every one of them has had a great experience so far.

Amanda Pyle, Elementary Principal, introduced Dustin Eck, 5th Grade Teacher, to explain the use of an Indiana Robotics grant that he and Dana Allan, also a 5th Grade Teacher, worked to acquire for EH. Mr. Eck described the vision of forming a Robotics Team of approximately 6-8 students initially where the students will build robots, doing 100% of the work, and then compete in robotics competitions such as VEXIQ. He also showed an actual robot as well as a video of one of the competitions used in tournaments.

Trisha Armstrong, Director of Technology, previewed the new website she has been working on that will be ADA compliant. The new site should be ready to launch on September 4.

Dr. McGuire explained that the new state law requires schools to give Highly Effective Teachers 25% more in grant money than the amount given to Effective Teachers. This has to officially be in our DOE Evaluation Plan. Mr. Jackson inquired if we know about how many teachers that will include. Trisha Armstrong stated that test scores should be released by the beginning of September and until then we cannot know for certain.

Dr. McGuire presented the Life/Fish Center Student Program that replaces the HMSES alternative setting for students. This has been done at Mt. Vernon for years, just under the HMSES heading. She reserved 1 seat for each center.

13 Request to Change School Hours on Monday, August 21, 2017

Minutes

Dr. McGuire explained the current situation regarding the solar eclipse scheduled for August 21. The special glasses ordered for the students to use outdoors to see the sun safely were not deemed to be 100% safe, so we cannot have students outside during the height of the eclipse. Estimates of eclipse time for our area are from approximately 12:57pm until 3:48pm, occurring exactly during school dismissal time. The school administrators met earlier and discussed possibly delaying the start of school an hour and extending dismissal an hour that day.

Mr. Petry moved and Mr. Jackson seconded a motion to approve changing school hours on Monday, August 21 to 9am--4:08pm for Elementary and 9:10am—4:14pm for MS/HS to ensure safety during the solar eclipse. Motion carried 4-0.

Dr. McGuire explained that we need to officially approved the addition of a Special Education program into the Eastern Hancock school system. Since Special Ed includes a Pre-K class, we also need to have our grade level reconfigured with the our state profile to reflect this.

Mr. Jackson moved and Mr. Lewis seconded a motion to approve having an Eastern Hancock based Special Education program on school grounds as well as to approve State School Profile Elementary Grade Level Reconfiguration from KG-05 to PK-05 due to the addition of our Special Education preschool. Motion carried 4-0.

The school policy has always been that students have to be picked up at the back door of their respective buildings. The concern is safety, so the administrators have decided to uphold the current policy for now.


