7 Annual Request to Participate in IU Addictive Behavior Survey

Minutes:

-Mr. David Pfaff, Superintendent, presented a request to allow middle and high school students to participate in IU's Institute for Research on Addictive Behavior Survey again in March of 2021. Mr. Pfaff explained that this is the 17th year Eastern Hancock has participated in this confidential and anonymous survey, and that in addition to providing the school with results that can assist us in better helping our own students as a whole, it is very useful when applying for school grants.

8 Child Lures Educational Program

Minutes:

-Mr. Pfaff then shared with the Board the Indiana state law requiring schools to provide training annually for students regarding child abuse and child sexual abuse. Mr. Pfaff, the school guidance counselors, and the building principals all recommend using the Child Lures program which is approved by the Indiana Department of Education. Child Lures will provide the virtual training as well as individuals for students to speak to who might wish to ask personal questions or disclose a personal situation. The curriculum is catered to the appropriate age groups.
