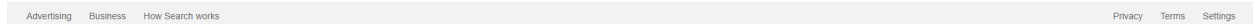
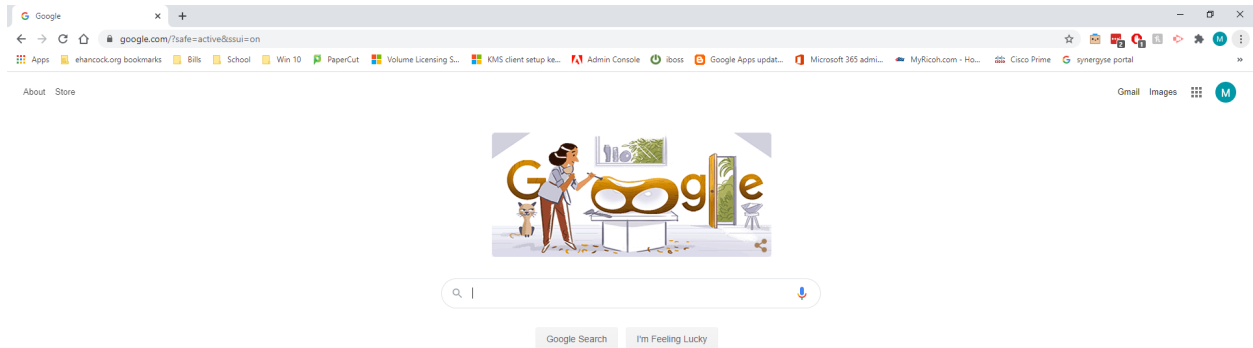
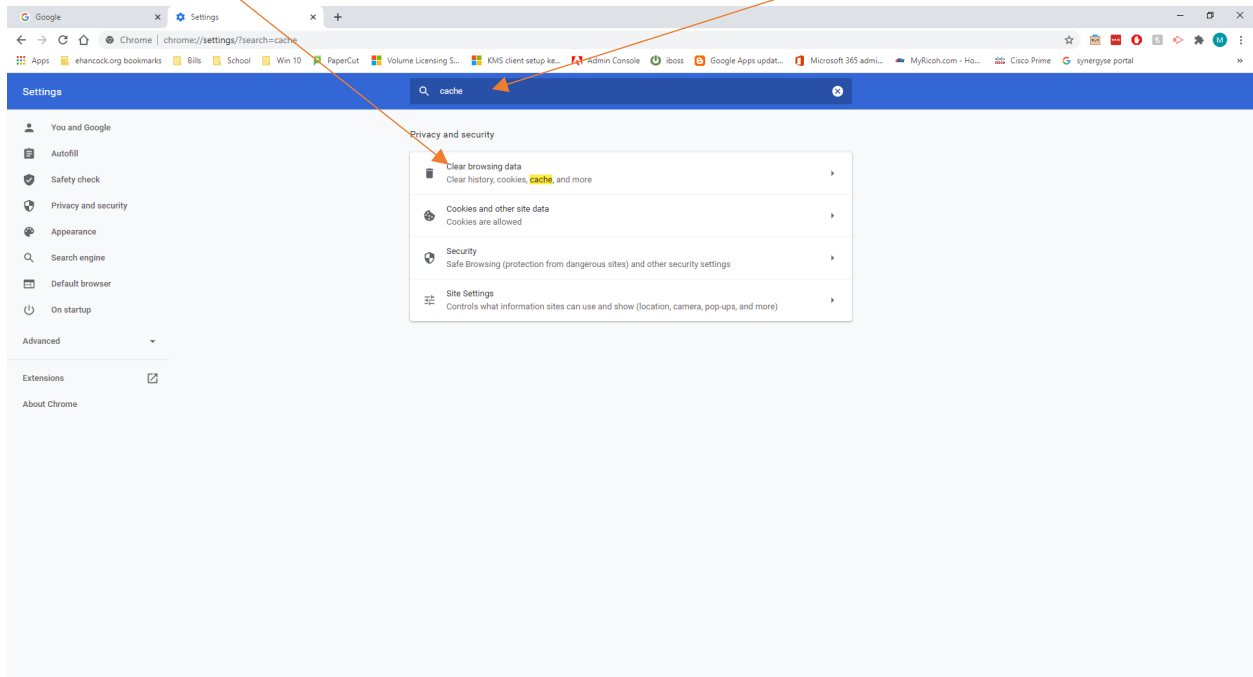


**For any Chromebook issues please follow the instructions below.**

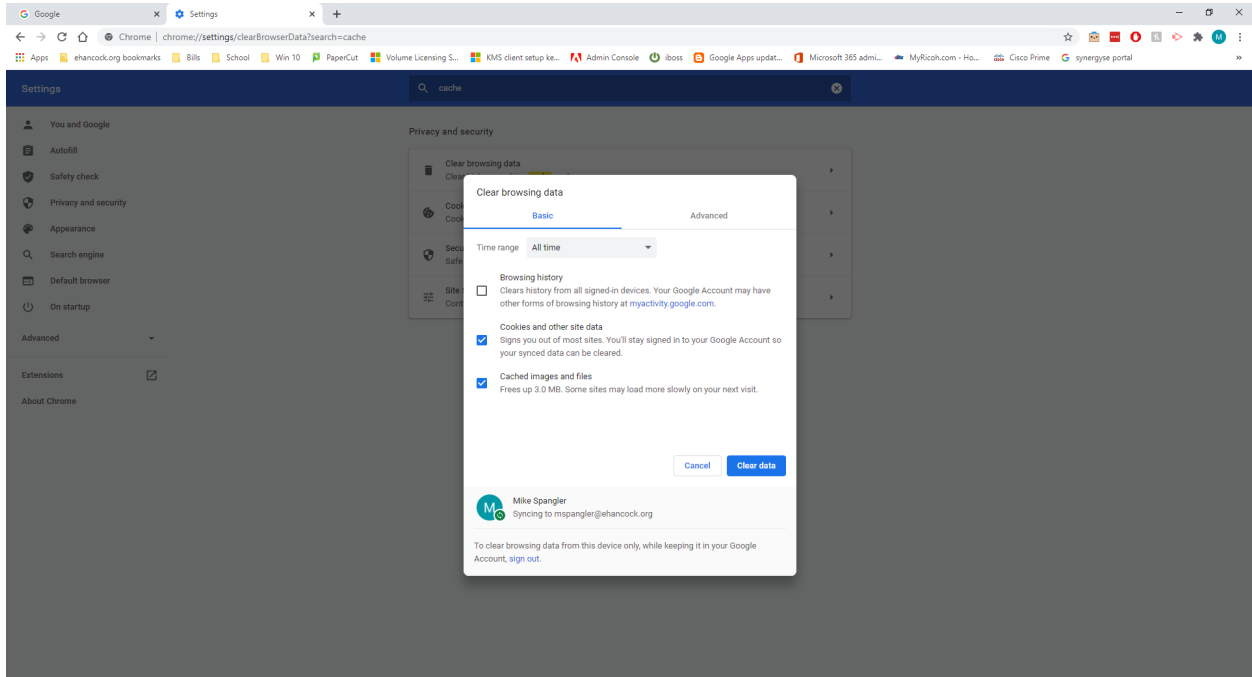
Open your Chrome Browser and click on the three dots just below the X on the top right of the screen. This will open a box that has different options in it. Click on settings within that box.



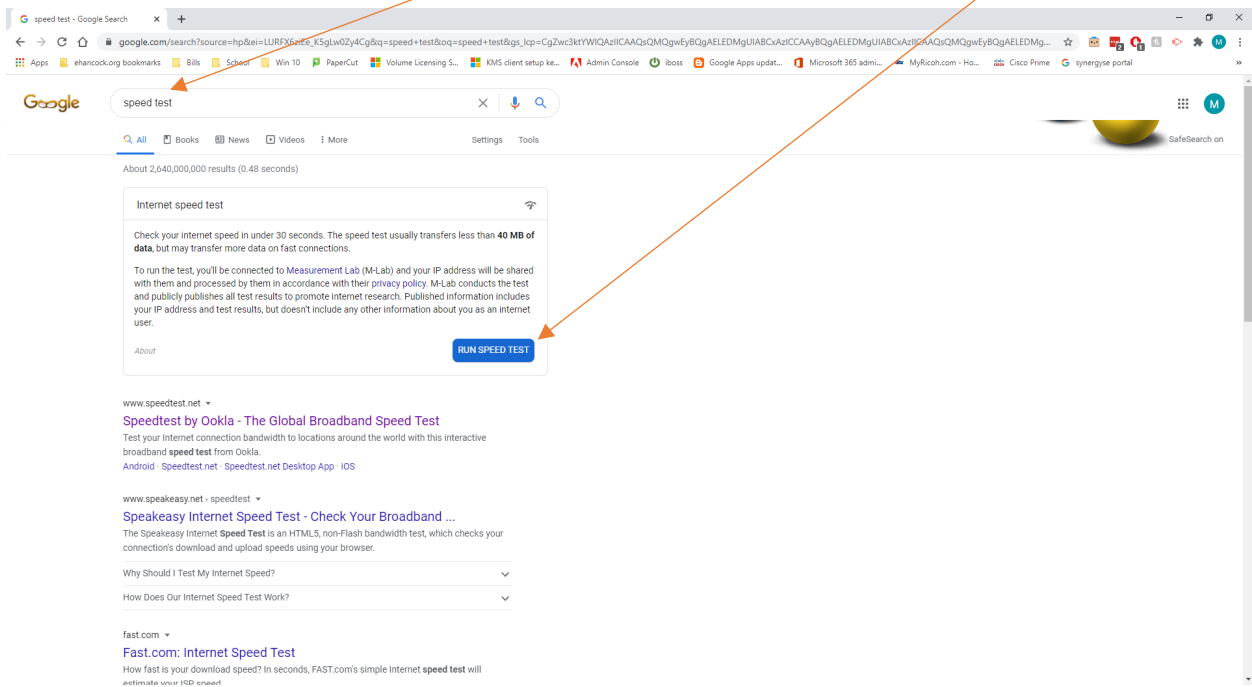
After clicking on settings, you will see a tab open like below. In the search bar type in "cache", and then click on "Clear browsing data".



After clicking on “Clear browsing data” a window will pop-up like below. Make sure the Time range is set to “All time” along with having “Cookies and other site data” and “Cached images and file” checked.



If you are still having issues do a “speed test” google search and click on “RUN SPEED TEST” like below.



You should see results like below. Make sure to record your results for the download and upload speed in case you need to contact the Technology Department.
